The JLC Summer Institute is a four and a half day summer professional development seminar for local educators in the Sacramento region. Teachers will gain knowledge about the judiciary and enhance their skills to effectively teach the role and operations of the courts while meeting Common Core Standards.

The Summer Institute will accept up to 25 secondary social science teachers through an application process. Each participant will receive a stipend of \$500 for their successful completion of a curricular unit based around local court cases for classroom use for entry into the JLC curriculum library. The institute will run Monday-Friday, June 19-23, 2017.
